AREA	8 hectares
TERROIR	clay-limestone, clay-gravel on south-facing hills
AVERAGE AGE OF THE VINES	40 years-old+
VARIETIES	82% Merlot, 18% Cabernet Franc
DENSITY OF PLANTATION	6 600 vines/hectares
VINEYARD MANAGEMENT	no chemical weed control, cereals and leguminous plants are grown to fertilize and oxygenate the soil.

The Vintage

A rainy winter that replenishes the water supplies, but **a difficult vintage** with a succession of rainfalls with temperatures favorable to mildew. **The beautiful and dry summer saved the vintage**, combined with low temperatures at night which resulted in fruits full of ripe tannins and aromatic freshness.

MATURATION	in barrels :40% new, 60% one-year old
LENGTH OF AGING	12 months in barrels, 12 months in vats
PRODUCTION	13 580 bottles and 131 magnums – 14.5% vol.
